## **GUIDED WALKING TOUR**

A walking tour through the city centre to discover the excellences of the UNESCO Heritage. In addition to its recognition as a **Creative City for Design** and as a **Biosphere Reserve with the MAB Collina Po**, Torino is home to some of the **Royal Residences** of the House of Savoy, which were declared a World Heritage Site in 1997.

Between the 16th and 18th centuries, the Savoy dynasty wanted to surround itself with a system of residences designed and built by the most important architects of the time: the theatre of court life and testimony to the authority acquired, places of leisure and pleasure palaces along the rivers, on the hills and in the countryside gave rise to what was called the 'Crown of Delights'.

Walking along Piazza Carignano, we find **Palazzo Carignano** (home to the National Museum of the Risorgimento) and the Academy of Sciences, which houses the famous Egyptian Museum, until we reach Piazza Castello, the heart of Torino, where the Royal Museums are located.

Here, the **Royal Palace** with the Armoury and the Chapel of the Holy Shroud, the Savoy Gallery, the Museum of Antiquities with the Archaeological Gallery and the Roman Theatre, the Royal Gardens, the Royal Library and the **Chiablese Rooms** are united in a single museum complex. They formed the heart of the political and cultural power of the House of Savoy.

Piazza Castello is also overlooked by **Palazzo Madama**, the Teatro Regio and the Church of San Lorenzo.
