DISCOVERING CANAVESE AND ITS UNESCO TREASURES

Don't miss the opportunity to discover this corner of Piedmont located few kilometeres from Torino.

Surrounded by rolling hills and green valleys, the Canavese holds a wealth of natural, historical and artistic treasures, including castles, towers and ancient churches.

8.30 am: transfer to Ivrea, the pearl of **Canavese**.

The city of Ivrea is surrounded by one of Europe's best-known morainic amphitheatres, formed during the great ice ages: the retreat of the Balteo glacier gave rise to the Serra d'Ivrea morainic cordon, which stretches for 25 km, and to numerous water basins such as the five lakes of Ivrea and those of Candia Canavese and Viverone.

9.30 am: arrival to **Ivrea**, coffee break and visit to the 20th Century Industrial City, a UNESCO World Heritage Site

The industrial city of Ivrea was built in the years between 1930 and 1960 by Adriano Olivetti, according to an alternative design to the national and international experiences implemented during the 20th century. The site consists of all the architecture connected to Adriano Olivetti's industrial and sociocultural project.

Following visit to the city centre to retrace the history of Ivrea and its monuments: the Mediaeval Castle, the Cathedral with its Romanesque bell towers and recently restored Crypt, the Bishop's Palace, the alleys of the upper city with their evocative views and the squares where the Battle of the Oranges takes place during the historic Carnival.

1.00 pm: lunch in a typical restaurant.

2.30 pm: transfer to **Agliè** and visit to the Ducal Castle of Agliè, one of the Royal Residences declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997.

The Ducal Castle of Agliè boasts an ancient and noble past, testified by the variety of arrangements that still characterize the flats and gardens. Surrounded by a park with century-old trees and large greenhouses, the castle has more than 300 rooms with a precious and heterogeneous heritage of furnishings and collections, ranging from paintings to archaeological finds and surprising ornithological and oriental collections.

5.30 pm: on the way back, stop for a tasting of Erbaluce di Caluso wine.

7.30 pm: dinner in a typical restaurant.

10.00 pm: back to the hotel in Torino.
